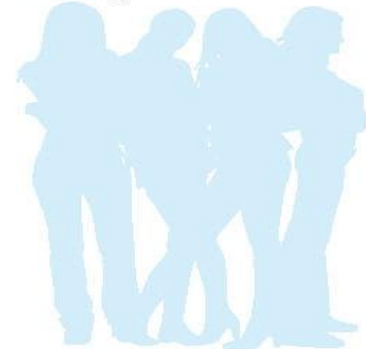

What is human trafficking?

To recruit, transact, take into bondage, transport, deliver, receive, harbor, hide, broker, or accommodate local or foreign person, by force, threat, intimidation, confinement, monitoring, drugs, hypnosis, fraud, purposeful concealment of important information, illegal debt bondage, withholding important document, making use of the subject's inability, ignorance or difficulty to seeking help, or by other means against the subject's will, for the intention or purpose of subjecting him/her to sexual transaction, labor exploitation or pay not commiserating with the labor, or the harvest of his/her organ.

To recruit, transact, take into bondage, transport, deliver, receive, harbor, hide, broker, or accommodate anyone under 18 years of age for the purpose of subjecting him/her to sex transaction, forced labor, or pay not commiserating with the labor, or the harvest of his/her organ or to subject anyone under 18 years of age to sexual transaction, labor exploitation or pay not commiserating with the labor, or the harvest of his/her organ.



Join Together to Stop Human Trafficking

How can we identify a victim?

- 1.Those who are under 18 years of age.
- 2.Have signs of violence or torture.
- 3.Identification or travel documents have been taken away.
- 4.Freedom is restricted, cannot leave at will or is always accompanied by others.
- 5.Unable to communicate with others at will.
- 6.Displays signs of guidance by others when answering questions from law enforcement officers.
- 7.Salary or sex trade income been inappropriately deducted.
- 8.Other possible signs of human trafficking.



Government Assistance Protection Arrangements

Any human trafficking victim who is in need of protection and sheltering as assessed by the competent authority of municipality or county (city), shall be provided protection and sheltering by the competent authority thereof provide protection such as:

- 1.Protection of personal safety
- 2.Necessary medical assistance
- 3.Assistance of interpreter
- 4.Legal assistance
- 5.Psychological counseling or therapy
- 6.Presence with the victim during questioning (interrogation) throughout the investigation or trial
- 7.Necessary financial assistance
- 8.Other necessary assistances

The central competent authority shall issue temporary visiting permit for duration of no more than 6 months to whom been identified as a human trafficking victim and without a valid visiting (or residency) permit. The permit can be extended temporarily if required by the investigation or trial of the case.

After continuous legal stay in the ROC for a period of five years and over 270 days per year, and also fit the conditions listed below, the victim may apply for permanent residency:

1. More than 20 years of age.
2. Possesses assets or the ability to support themselves.
3. Conforming to the national interests of Taiwan.

After being placed under protection and sheltering, and issued a temporary visiting permit, if leaves the shelter without permission or violates laws or regulations, the competent authority or labor affairs competent authority may revoke his/her temporary visiting permit, and may detain or deport the subject if the violation is deemed to be sufficiently serious.

Work Permit

Human trafficking victims must apply to the central government's labor agency for a work permit. They will not be subject to the restrictions noted in the Employment Services Act or Article 11 of the Regulations Governing the Relations between the People of the Taiwan Area and the People of the Mainland China Area. The time of residency will not exceed the period of the work permit.

Compensation

Central government agencies should establish a compensatory fund for the victims of human trafficking to apply for their compensation.
